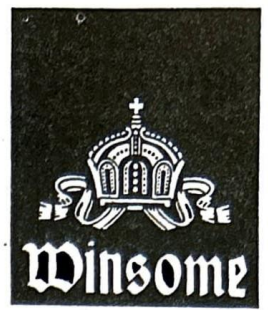

World Bank keen for Rs. 2500 cr Green Resilient programme in HP

500 MW solar energy to be harnessed by 2024

HP Chief Minister Thakur Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu in a meeting with the World Bank team, headed by Regional Director (Sustainable Development), South Asia Region, Mr. John Roome here on Monday discussed the Green agenda of the State and the measures to be adopted to achieve the target of 'Green Energy State' by 2025, with the assistance of World Bank.

The World Bank indicated that it is keen on Green Resilient Integrated Development programme for the state with Basin approach with an estimated cost size of Rs. 2,500 crore (300 Million US dollars) depending upon the technical analyses, which may be enhanced further.

The visit of the team was going to be a landmark for the transformation of State towards Green Resilient Himachal, said the Chief Minister and highlighted the priorities in terms of Green Agenda for the State.

"As a step towards achieving the target, the State has fixed a time-bound action



plan to achieve installation of 200 MW solar power energy projects in next nine months and state will acquire more land for the installation of 500 MW by end of the year 2024", said the Chief Minister.

Transformation towards adoption of Electric Vehicles in the State is of utmost priority and hopes for generous contribution and launch of some key programmes from the World Bank for this purpose, said Sh. Sukhu. Mak-

ing his intentions clear, Chief Minister said that maximum departments would be switched over to Electric Vehicles (EVs) by next year in the first phase.

Apart from this the Chief Minister also indicated to the team that the State is all set to go ahead in line with National Green Hydrogen Energy Mission in a big way apart from the production. Though the technique of production of Green hydrogen is expensive yet the gov-

ernment will consult Indian Oil Corporation for the same as IOC has taken the first significant step towards Green Hydrogen Economy in India with the commissioning of country's first pure Green Hydrogen pilot plant in Northeast. The Government is committed to make Himachal as the first non-polluted State by reducing carbon emissions completely, claimed Chief Minister.

Mr. John Roome appre-

ciated the farsightedness of Sh. Sukhu for achieving a target of Green and Clean State and said that such commitment and initiatives were a good beginning and wished success in this direction. He said that the EV policy envisioned by the Chief Minister would be taken up on priority and shortly a team from the Bank would visit the state for technical analysis.

Discussions about the future plan of action of the World Bank in the implementation of various programmes in the State focusing on Sustainable Forest Management, Community Forestry, Ecosystem Services, and Disaster Management along the Basins, Water Resource Management, Nature-Based Tourism and Payment on Ecosystem Services were also held. The World Bank agreed upon providing its support in the implementation of proposed projects.

Chief Parliamentary Secretary Sanjay Awasthi, Chief Secretary Prabhodh Saxena and other senior officers attended the meet-

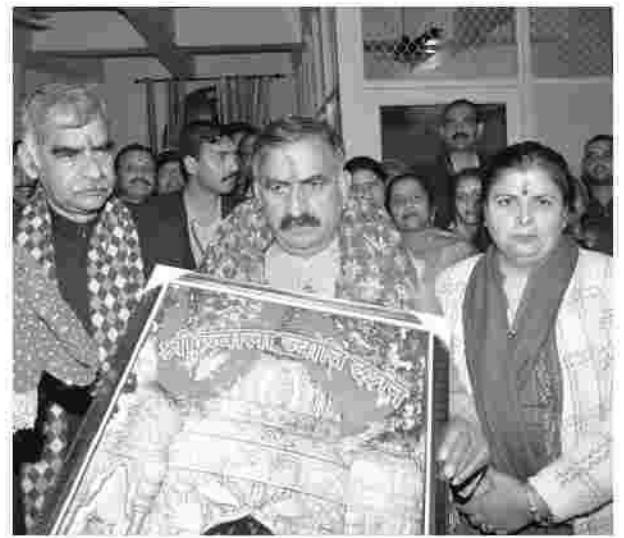

SJVN registers 37.98% growth in 9 months

Satuj Jal Vidyut Nigam Ltd (SJVN) has recorded Profit After Tax (PAT) of Rs 1349.48 crores for three quarters of the current financial year, which is 37.98% more than the corresponding period of previous fiscal.

Speaking after the Board Meeting of Company on Monday, Dr Sharma stated that for the third quarter Profit After Tax increased by 25.06%, which is Rs. 290.98 Crores compared to Rs. 232.67 Crores during corresponding period last year.

Dr Sharma lauded collective efforts and hard work of the employees. "These positive growth percentiles are result of optimum utilization of our operating units, relentless quest to excellence, adopting best financial practices and strategic focus on capacity addition in the portfolio of the company."

Dr Sharma informed that SJVN's Net Worth has jumped to Rs. 14,261.09 crores at the end of 3rd

quarter of 2022-23 as compared to Rs. 13581.36 crores during last year. SJVN has also upped its Earning Per Share (EPS) registering an increase of 38.15% as compared to corresponding period of previous year. Similarly, Company has accounted an increase of 11.37% in the Profit Before Tax (PBT). Displaying an excellent financial performance during first three quarters of current fiscal, the Company has earned total Revenues of Rs. 2715.48 crore from operations during these three quarters.

Agra metro to be completed before schedule: UP CM

Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Monday inaugurated the construction of the Agra Metro rail tunnel at a ground-breaking ceremony held at Ramlila Maidan in front of Agra Fort.

The CM first signed the ring segment on his arrival at the launching shaft at Ramlila Maidan, offered prayers and then pressed the button, formally kicking off the tunnel construction.

The Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) in Agra has been named after Ganga and Yamuna. This tunnel boring machine will prepare up to 10-12 meters of tunnels every day.

Two parallel tunnels are to be constructed for the up-and-down track in the underground part of the Agra Metro by the UP Metro Corporation.

In his brief speech on the occasion, CM Yogi said that the Metro Rail and the upcoming G-20 event will promote Agra globally as an important investment and tourist destination.

"G-20 is a group of the most prestigious countries of the world. India has got the



honour of presiding over the forum under the leadership of PM Modi. Four cities of UP have been selected for holding the G-20 summits of which three meetings will be held in Agra," said Yogi Adityanath.

"The first summit will be held on February 10, 11, 12 and 13 while two summits will be held in the month of August. A total of 11 G-20 meetings will be held in Varanasi, Lucknow, Gautam Buddha Nagar and Agra," he said.

Expressing his satisfaction over the ongoing preparations for the G-20 in Agra, Yogi said, "With the spirit of 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam' and 'One Earth, One Family and One Future' we will present India's rich legacy of

treating guests with the spirit of Atithi Devo Bhava to the delegates."

"I am glad that the local administration, public representatives and public have joined hands to make the much anticipated event successful in terms of boosting tourism and opening up new avenues of investment in Agra," he added.

He said that work on the six-kilometre-long priority corridor, having 3 km each elevated and underground tunnels being built as part of Agra Metro' was going on in full swing and was expected to be completed six months ahead of schedule.

The CM said the deadline set for completion of the priority corridor is August 2024, but the authorities are mov-

ing ahead with full commitment to complete the work 6 months ahead of time while following the TIZ's guidelines and complying with all environmental standards.

He said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi took part in the Bhumi Pujan ceremony of Agra Metro in December 2020.

He said, "For the development of public transport as well as tourism facilities and better employment generation in Agra, the people's representatives have been demanding this state-of-the-art means of public transport for a long time.

"It is our effort that by December, we will complete the work of the Priority Corridor which is about 6 km long. Meanwhile, two corridors with a length of 29.4 km have already been approved to be developed here."

Expressing his gratitude to the Prime Minister and the Union Government for their contribution towards the construction of Agra Metro and congratulating officials of the UP Metro Corporation and Agra Metro for their dedicated hard work, Yogi said that the project was progressing rapidly and would

be completed on time. He said that Agra Metro will be equipped with state-of-the-art facilities.

The CM also thanked the public representatives and the people for their cooperation. It may be noted that a total of 7 underground stations and underground tunnels will be built through tunnel boring machines Ganga and Yamuna. Agra Metro is to have a network of 29.4 km long two corridors, which will have 27 stations.

The construction work of the 14 km long first corridor between Taj East Gate and Sikandra is progressing at a fast pace. As many as 13 stations will be constructed in this corridor, including 6 elevated and 7 underground stations.

IIT Mandi develop new technology to make military equipment invisible to radar

Researchers at the Indian Institute of Technology Mandi have created an artificial structure/material that can make stealth vehicles and well as covert establishments less visible to the radar. This material can absorb a wide range of radar frequencies (signals), irrespective of the direction from which the radar signal hits the target. It can also be used to cover windows or glass panels of stealth vehicles and covert establishments that must be invisible to radar. The results of this work is published in the journal, IEEE Letters on Electromagnetic Compatibility, Practice and Applications, co-authored by Dr Shrikanth Reddy, Assistant Professor, School of Computing and Electrical Engineering, IIT Mandi and his team Dr. Awanish Kumar (First Author) and Mr. Jyoti Bhushan Padhi.

Radars are used in defence and civil sectors for



surveillance, and navigation, to detect and track: aircraft, ships, ground vehicles, and movements within in covert establishments. Being invisible to radar is a crucial defence strategy and the ability to evade radar detection can reduce the chances of being targeted by enemy weapons. Any technique that makes things invisible to radar can also be used in the commercial sector to reduce radiation leakages from buildings and make them more secure. For example, invisibility to radar can also be used in private or covert establishments for the protection of information and privacy. RCS reduction is a

way to make something less visible to radar - RCS stands for Radar Cross Section. RCS reduction is achieved by using materials that can absorb radar signals, or by shaping the object in a way that makes it difficult for radar to detect. Explaining the research, Dr G Shrikanth Reddy, IIT Mandi, said, "We have developed a technology based on Frequency Selective Surface (FSS) that absorbs a wide range of frequencies used in radar, which makes the surface invisible to radar."

The proposed design uses an optically transparent ITO-coated PET sheet where the FSS patterns are created on this PET sheet. The FSS pattern on the PET sheet were created with the laser engraving technology, and due to symmetrical and lossy nature of FSS patterns, the proposed absorber is polarization insensitive and absorbs a wide range of EM wave frequencies within in C, X and Ku Band.
