Chilla elevated road may be approved

While AAP leader Atishi met the girl's family members, Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal announced an ex-gratia sum of Rs 10 lakh to her kin to help them tide over the tragedy.

Do something about law and order in Delhi: Kejriwal to LG

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Tuesday asked Lieutenant Governor V K Saxena to rein in the "collapsed" law and order in the city which has seen two cold blooded murders this week alone.

Reacting to the killing of a beauty parlour worker in Majnu Ka Tila, Kejriwal said, "What is happening in our Delhi? The law and order situation has completely collapsed. LG sir, do something."

that "such incidents can be averted if LG takes responsibility." "Daughters of Delhi are facing violence every day. Such incidents can be averted only if the LG takes responsibility," she alleged.

Another leader of the Aam Aadmi Party, Saurabh

Bharadwaj, lashed out at the LG over the horrific killing saying the people of Delhi have "lost faith" in the national capital's law and order system.

"We urge the LG to hold a press conference and give us the information on how many police stations he has visited so far. The LG has zero accountability. If this was some other country, people would start asking for the Home Minister's resignation. People don't wish to come forward to help because they think they will be falsely framed by the police," Bharadwaj alleged.

Kejriwal too had on Monday urged Saxena to take strict action in the murder incident.

The Delhi Police comes under the Union Home Ministry. The AAP which governs the city has been firm in its pursuit to wrest the control of police in Delhi to the elected government.

BJP MP Hans Raj Hans who met the girl's family Tuesday morning said no amount of money can bring the family its daughter back.

"The family has lost its world. Daughters are considered goddess Lakshmi. We can just console them and provide some financial help," Hans told reporters after meeting the victim's kin.

The BJP delegation accompanying Hans extended its sympathy to the family and gave a "small interim financial support" to them, said a statement from the BJP's Delhi unit.

Hans also condemned the AAP for "politicising" the

murder and using it to score political brownie points.

Delhi Congress President Anil Chaudhary, who also visited the family members of the victim, said "blame game begins" between Kejriwal and LG every time the "government is held accountable." "Several such incidents have happened since 2013 but whenever the government is held accountable, Arvind Kejriwal and the LG start their blame game," Chaudhary said.

Meanwhile, DCW chairperson Swati Malwal too met the girl's family.

Sharpshooter of Hasim Baba gang arrested by crime branch

A sharpshooter of Hasim Baba gang named Sehazad has been arrested by Delhi police's crime branch, said Delhi police on Tuesday.

Sehazad alias Samir alias Asif alias Raja (43), a resident of Indira Vihar, Delhi, was in a murder case of Jama Masjid police station area. He was previously involved in two criminal cases, they said.

Ravindra Singh Yadav, Special Commissioner of Police, Crime said that an information was received to crime branch that the above wanted criminal Sehazad alias Asif would come to Delhi Cantt. Railway Station.

"Based on technical surveillance, a trap was laid by

a police team of AEKC, Crime branch led by inspector Rajeev Bamal under the close supervision of ACP Sushil Kumar and the accused was apprehended from Delhi Cantt. Railway Station," DCP mentioned.

"During interrogation, the accused revealed that he works for Hasim Baba gang and usually visits Kabutar Market, Jama Masjid for the sale and purchase of birds. He further disclosed that on April 28, he got direction from Hashim Baba when he had come Patiala House Court from jail to attend the trial to kill Furkan in order to take revenge of beating Sehazad's son on April, 23," DCP said.

"Later on evening, he along with his associates Shanu, Burhan and Maya had gone to kill Furkan but shot dead Furkan's brother Imran alias Nanhe in Kabutar Market, Jama Masjid, DCP further said.

Other associates involved in the murder case were arrested by local police. Hasim Baba gang operates in the area of East, North-East and Shahdara districts of Delhi, the official further added.

hard core criminal carrying reward of Rs 50 K arrested by spl cell

The special cell of Delhi arrested a hard core criminal carrying a reward of Rs 50 thousand on his arrest, said Delhi police on Tuesday.

The accused identified as Dinesh Kumar alias Dina (49), a resident of Uttar Pradesh's Aligarh was wanted in a NDPS case of Crime Branch, Delhi. He was previously involved in several cases of NDPS Act, Murder, Attempt to Murder, Abduction, Arms Act etc. in Delhi and Uttar Pradesh.

Alok Kumar, DCP, Special cell said that on May, 29, specific input was received that the accused Dinesh alias Dina, who was declared a proclaimed offender in an NDPS case of crime branch, would come to Sarai Kale Khan Bus Stand, Delhi to meet his associate.

"Subsequently, a team of Trans-Yamuna Range, Special Cell led by inspector Sunil Teotia under the supervision of ACP Rahul Kumar Singh and Kailash Bisht laid a trap at the above location and apprehended him in the morning hours," Alok Kumar, DCP, Special cell mentioned.

Accused Dinesh Kumar alias Dina was a practicing Advocate at Aligarh Courts. In 2009, he was arrested in a murder case wherein he had killed one Chunna in family enmity. In 2020, he was arrested by Crime Branch, Delhi with 84 Kg Marijuana. In November, 2021, he was granted 30 days interim bail by the court on the ground of his wife's illness.



AAP leader Atishi too urged the LG to break his "silence" over the murder which came two days after the horrific killing of a minor girl in northwest Delhi's Shahbad Dairy area.

"LG sir, at least say something. How long will you remain silent? You have the constitutional responsibility to provide security to the daughters of Delhi. I request you - improve the law and order system of Delhi," Atishi said in a tweet.

Beauty parlour worker killed by flatmate in Delhi's Majnu Ka Tila area

A 36-year-old woman was arrested for allegedly killing her flatmate early Tuesday morning for abusing her father who had died three months ago, police said.

Sapna, the accused, worked as a waitress or a decorator for parties. She is divorced and has a daughter, they said.

The incident took place in Majnu Ka Tila in north Delhi's Civil Lines area, police said, adding they were informed about the incident around 7 am.

On reaching the spot, police found the body of 35-year-old Rani lying in a pool of blood with Sapna also there, a senior police officer said.

During interrogation, Sapna broke down and confessed to the crime, police said.

She told police that she



continued drinking. Around 4.30 am, they again had an altercation which turned into a scuffle during which Sapna stabbed Rani with a kitchen knife in her chest.

The trigger for the assault, Sapna told police, was Rani's abusing her dead father. Rani was rushed to a nearby hospital where she succumbed immediately, police said.

Deputy Commissioner of Police (North) Sagar Singh Kalsi said, "Teams of FSL and crime have inspected the spot. We have registered a case of murder under section 302 of the Indian Penal Code. Based on the investigation, the accused Sapna was arrested after she confessed to her crime. Efforts are being taken to recover the weapon of offence."

After the post mortem, Rani's body will be handed over to her family, police said.

On Monday night, Sapna and Rani along with a group of friends had a dinner party till around 1 am at their friend Neha's house in Aruna Nagar area of Majnu Ka Tila. During the party, Sapna and Rani, who were both drunk, had a fight, he said.

After the party, they both returned to their flat and
