

Parents held for sexual human trafficking

Muzaffarnagar: The police here have arrested a couple for alleged sexual exploitation and trafficking of their foster child, police said Monday. In September this year, the 17-year-old girl was found unconscious near a canal. She was given medical treatment and sent back to her foster parents on September 25 by an NGO. But later after a complaint, the NGO members confronted her guardians and rescued her. In her medical examination, it was found that the girl was sexually exploited. On October 6, police registered a case against her foster parents under sections of rape and human trafficking of the Indian Penal Code and the Protection Of Children From Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act at Bhopa police station. The two were arrested on Sunday evening, police said. The victim's real father died. Her mother remarried and relocated to some other place and couldn't be traced, according to police. The victim is currently at a shelter home.

BSF jawan killed his wife

Rajesh Tomar Agra: A BSF jawan killed his wife at village Garhi Harichand of Shamsabad police station. On getting information about the incident, the police also reached the spot. The suspected BSF jawan was taken into custody by the local police for interrogation. During interrogation, it has come to know that the BSF jawan had recently come home on leave. Last night he drank alcohol and assaulted his wife. After that, he hanged her body from the fan. The brother of the deceased said that this morning he was informed that his sister was calling all of you. On reaching the spot, he found his sister's body hanging. There were marks of injuries on her body.

Non-bailable warrant issued against gangster Anil Dujana

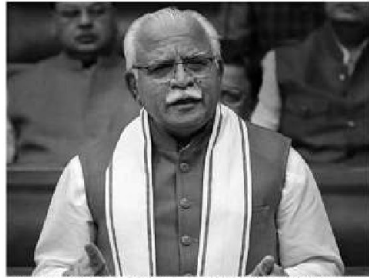
Muzaffarnagar: A local court here has issued a non-bailable warrant against gangster Anil Dujana. Several people, including Dujana, are facing trial in the murder case of a trader who was shot dead in 2017 in Chapar village, which is situated on the Delhi-Dehradun national highway. Additional District Sessions Judge Shakti Singh issued the arrest warrant and directed the police to bring him to court before November 10. Meanwhile Bulandshar police have announced a reward of Rs 25,000 on information leading to Dujana's arrest.

Two arrested by Meghalaya Police in cyber fraud case

Shillong: A Nigerian man and a woman were arrested by the Meghalaya Police from Delhi in a cyber fraud case, officials said on Monday. A police team from the East Garo Hills district apprehended the duo from Tilak Nagar in west Delhi on Sunday with the help of Delhi Police, they said. They were arrested in a Rs 2 lakh cyber fraud case, lodged at the Williamsnagar police station, officials said.

Farmers' issue can be resolved only through dialogue, says Haryana CM

Jag Mohan Thakur Chandigarh: Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar said that the government is making constant efforts to open the Singhu and Tikri borders which were closed by the farmers, and said the problem can be solved only through dialogue. He said that Haryana Government has constituted a committee under the chairmanship of Home Secretary in this matter. Discussions are underway. Along with this, the Supreme Court has also taken cognizance in this matter. Due to the closure of the border, the people traveling along with the local residents and traders are facing inconvenience. The Chief Minister said that the people blocking the highway should understand the problem and come forward for dialogue. CM Khattar said that to develop coordination between farmers and traders in the mandis during the procurement of crops, appointment of office bearers of the market committees would be done before the procurement process of the upcoming Rabi crop. He said that the work of the committees is to establish coordination between farmers and traders in the mandis during the procurement of crops. This time the crop procurement is almost complete. Soon the government will take a decision in this regard.



Haryana Chief Minister said that transparency in jobs is the main aim of his government. Complete transparency is being exercised in the recruitments being done by Haryana Staff Selection Commission and Haryana Public Service Commission. He said that the government has provided 83,000 government jobs over a period of 7 years without Parochialism. The Chief Minister was answering questions during a press conference organized on the 56th Haryana Day on Monday.

Interacting with the media persons, he said that people were appreciating the transparency brought about in the recruitment process. The latest example of this is the recruitment of women sub-inspectors in Haryana Police, in which 58 out of 64 girls were selected from poor families and one from their family was a government employee. They were selected on the basis of merit. Along with this, the Chief Minister also gave the example of a woman sub-inspector selected from Meow district. He said that the selected girl herself called him and informed that she is the first girl from Meow district who has been recruited as sub-inspector and she is from a poor family. The Chief Minister said that the government is strict with the gangs involved in cheating and fraud in recruitments and exams. Action is being taken against such people continuously. He said that during the tenure of the previous governments, either FIR was not registered against such people, even if it was, it was thrown away. The Chief Minister said that so far our government has registered 42 FIRs on such gangs and arrested the accused. Apart from this, action is also being taken against those issuing fake appointment letters in the name of recruitment in the Vidhan Sabha. Replying to another question, the Chief Minister said that the Common Entrance Test for Group-C and D is likely to be conducted by March 2022. A letter has been written to the agency

conducting it. So far 7.5 lakh youth have registered for this. Whenever a job advertisement will be released, its portal will be opened again for registration, he said. Responding to a question, the Chief Minister said that in the coming days, he will visit all the 90 assembly constituencies of the state and interact with the people. Due to such Corona pandemic, the tours could not be conducted for some time. Now the programmes for the next two months have been prepared, during which the Chief Minister will visit the people. The Chief Minister said that Haryana Police is doing a better job to check crime. Police patrolling has been increased. 650 new vehicles have also been provided to the police department, through which patrolling is being done continuously.

All is ready for today's counting of HP bye-polls

Sushil Kumar Sharma Shimla: Chief Electoral Officer of the state C. Palrasu said here today that all preparations have been completed for the counting of votes for by-elections to the Mandi parliamentary constituency and Fatehpur, Jubbal-Kotkhai and Arki Assembly constituencies. He said that the counting of votes would be started on

November 2, 2021 from 8 am amidst tight security at the respective centres. A counting assistant and a counting supervisor will be posted at each table other than the returning officer's table in the counting centre. C. Palrasu said that 11 counting observers have been deployed for Mandi parliamentary constituency, whereas for Fatehpur, Arki and Jubbal-Kotkhai Assemblies



by constituencies, only three general observers have been posted as counting observers. Apart from this, one micro observer has also been deployed at each counting table. The Chief Electoral Officer

said that two separate centers have been set up for counting of the postal ballot papers and ETPBS votes of Mandi parliamentary constituency. Similarly, a separate center has also been set up in Fatehpur, Arki and Jubbal-Kotkhai assembly constituencies for counting of postal ballots and ETPBS votes. He also informed that in compliance with the guidelines

issued in view of the Covid-19 epidemic there will be a ban on taking out victory processions by the winning candidates or their supporters after the declaration of the results. Apart from this, not more than two people will be allowed to accompany the winning candidate or his authorized representative at the time of taking the election certificate from the Returning Officer.

Beautification of Brij Chaurasi Parikrama Marg discussed



TSN/Mathura: A meeting was held between Teerth Purohits and Brij Yatra organisers and the district administration for the beautification of Brij Chaurasi Kos Parikrama Marg. A roadmap was prepared in the meeting after extensive talks on the development and beautification of the ancient routes of Brij Chaurasi

Kos Yatra. The Tirth Purohits informed about widening of the parikrama route, pavements and main roads connecting one village to another and the major scenic spots falling between them, Prachi Kund, lakes, forest parks and their ancient contacts. While making them aware of the routes, Brijyatra was equipped with friendly facilities, in which the resting place at the prescribed distance, the trees on both sides of the road, were made aware of the topics, as well as the pilgrimage sites mentioned in the Puranas and certified by the masters of the four sects and from their halting places. In the first phase, it was approved to prepare a detailed plan for the development of ancient rural connectivity routes of Brij Chaurasi Kos Yatra. District Magistrate Navneet Chahal, chief executive officer of UP Brij Teerth Vikas Parishad, Nagendra Pratap and Teerth Purohiti, Sardar Kantanath Chaturvedi of Chaturvedi Samaj, councilor Vishnu Mandir Siva Sansthan Ramdas Chaturvedi, and others were present in the meeting.

SP Chief become Akhilesh Ali Jinnah, says Maurya



UP deputy chief minister Keshav Prasad Maurya alleged that Akhilesh Yadav's party has become SP Nawazwadi party, while Akhilesh Yadav has become Akhilesh Ali Jinnah. He has insulted the martyrs of the country, for which he should apologise. Maurya was talking to reporters in Hapur. He said that BJP government is coming again in UP due to which the opposition parties are furious. The workers should go from house to house and tell the policies of BJP to the public.

Paid News Case traced in Arki bye-poll favouring a candidate

Sushil Kumar Sharma Shimla: Media Certification and Monitoring Committee (MC&MC) traced a case of 'paid news' on the base of news items appeared in favour of BJP candidate. The MC&MC Solan took the cognizance of a news item on October 18 which was about Election campaign of a BJP candidate. Committee found that similar news items and having similar photographs appeared in four news paper. Notice was issued to Rattan Pal BJP candidate of Arki Assembly Constituencies on October 21, 2021. SDM Arki issued notice to candidate on October 21 stating that Media Certification & Monitoring Committee had taken cognizance on October 18 news item appeared in various news papers, Amar Ujala, Dainik Jagran, Himachal Dastak and Dainik Saveri. Notice said that same contents of news in various papers is self explanatory of

paid news and is clear cut violation of Model Code of Conduct. The news items appeared in various papers about Mangal Pandey former in-charge, political affairs campaigning in favour of BJP candidate Ratan pal. Show cause notice was also issued to party candidate that why action should not be taken under section 77 (4) of RP Act, 1957. Notice said that Rattan Singh Pal should be given one opportunity to explain his stand on the above mentioned news within 48 hours from the receipt of this notice, failing to which decision of MC&MC will be final without any further reference to him. In reply to Returning Officer cum SDM Arki, BJP candidate's election agent Harish Kaushal on October 23 denied of charge stating that notice was wrong and false. We have not violated any condition of Model Code of Conduct as imposed by Election Commission of India and by our good office, he added.

Party, however, accepted that Mangal Pandey had visited Arki Vidhan Sabha as mentioned in the news item and he campaigned in favour of party Candidate. Mangal Pandey is a national leader of BJP and he was the youngest State President of Bihar BJP and remained in-charge of BJP HP for five years and presently he is Health Minister of Bihar Government. He had addressed some meetings during his visit as per his tour programme which was published in many newspapers and his entire tour was covered by the media but neither candidate nor any of candidate's agent ever approach and asked any newspaper as mentioned by you to publish any content news as alleged. Candidate had not violated any MCC and the allegation is unfair, derogatory and defamatory that it was a paid news. This is wild imagination devoid of any evidence. We reserve the right to

defend the defamatory allegation in court of law', warned the party agent in reply to the notice. BJP agent also said that even the contents and photographs are different in different newspapers as such it appear that someone is either biased or have conspired against BJP Candidate. Party demanded to withdraw the notice. After receiving the reply on October 27, a meeting of District Level Media Certification and Monitoring Committee was held under the chairmanship of District Election Officer and Deputy Commissioner, Solan, Krutika Kulhari, in which members of the committee SDM Arki Ajay Kumar Yadav, Correspondent, Doodarshan and All India Radio, Solan Laxmi Dutt Sharma, Editor Himalayan Dawn Baldev Chahban, District Public Relation Officer Hemant Vats, read the reply of election agent of Rattan Singh Pal candidate.
