He said this during the interaction with the school heads that there is a need for our school heads to take education in Delhi to a new dimension by sharing the experiences and best practices of their schools amongst themselves. A Cluster Leadership Development (CLDP) program was organized for the professional develop-

ment and leadership upskilling of school heads of government schools in Delhi on Friday.

Speaking on the occasion, Sisodia said, "This program plays a multifaceted role for the education ecosystem. If this program is not in place, then many aspects of edu-

cation will remain untouched. This program has helped in creating an environment of education leadership."

Sisodia said, "CLDP has

made a significant contribution in creating a better education ecosystem. It has

taken education to new heights but now there is a need to work beyond this. Now CLDP needs to be rethought.

CLDP is no longer confined to just a cluster of schools but has to move out of it and engage with the community. For this, our school heads have to play a role as education leaders. This will not only benefit the schools of a cluster but also the rest of the citizens living within the geographical radius of that cluster and an environment for education will be created in the entire region."

On this occasion, the school heads shared their experiences learned from CLDP with Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia and said that before this training, it was very difficult to find solutions to the problems
